2. Written statements of witnesses and memoranda reporting or summarizing oral statements made by witnesses, if any, are contained in discovery tendered to the defense in open court.



4. The following items may be offered into evidence by the People at the time of the trial of this cause:


A Digital Copy of illinoiscorruption.net including all hyperlinks and attached files
