
STIPULATION

It is hereby stipulated between the parties, the People of the State of Illinois by their attorney, Anita Alvarez, through her Assistants, Robert Podlasek and Julie Gunnigle, and by the defendant, Anabel Melongo through her attorney, Nick Albukerk that:

1. Annabel Melongo has maintained a website, www.illinoiscorruption.net, beginning on or about November 3, 2009 and continuing through and including March 3, 2010.
2. That Annabel Melongo recorded telephone conversations with Pamela Taylor on December 14, 15, and 16, 2009.
3. That on or about December 18, 2009 Annabel Melongo posted three (3) audio recordings, and accompanying transcripts of those three (3) audio recordings of conversations between Annabel Melongo and Pamela Taylor of the Court Reporter's Office on Annabel Melongo's website, www.illinoiscorruption.net.


4. That the website, www.illinoiscorruption.net, is a website on the World Wide Web which is accessible to the general public.
5. If called to testify the Keeper of the Records for Wild West Domains, the registrar and host of the website, www.illinoiscorruption.net, would testify that the website, www.illinoiscorruption.net, was maintained and controlled by Annabel Melongo beginning on or about November 3, 2009 and continuing through and including March 3, 2010.
6. That on or about December 18, 2009, the website, www.illinoiscorruption.net. Had a posted three (3) audio recordings, and accompanying transcripts of those three (3) audio recordings of conversations between Annabel Melongo and Pamela Taylor of the Court Reporter's Office.
7. That the post states that on December 14, 15, and 16, 2009, Annabel Melongo called the Court Reporter's Office on three (3) separate occasions and spoke to Pamela Taylor. The post further states that Anabel Melongo recorded the conversations.
8. That on or about January 13, 2010 members of the Illinois Attorney General's High Tech Crimes Bureau Digital Forensics Lab in Chicago, digitally preserved a true and accurate copy of the website, www.illinoiscorruption.net, which is offered as People's Exhibit #1 into evidence.
