Dear Anita Alvarez,

My name is Annabel Melongo and I writing today regarding case No. 08CR10502. This case has been ongoing for 3 years and I will really appreciate if you can look into it, so to clean up Richard Devine's actions. The case was first filed and dismissed in Rolling Meadows (06MC3006880) for lack of evidence. Richard Devine then pushed it to court via a Grand Jury .
